### Biography

Dr. Seung-Woo Lee is currently an associate professor at the Department of Life Sciences of POSTECH. Dr. Lee received his PhD at POSTECH for studying DNA vaccine development against hepatitis C virus and trained as a postdoctoral fellow and senior scientist at La Jolla Institute for Allergy and Immunology (LIAI), San Diego, USA for studying T cell co-stimulation and immune cell development. He has been interested in how the epithelial cells interplay with immune cells in health and diseases, particularly focusing on the mucosal tissues such as the intestines and lung. Furthermore, he has been interested in cancer immunology & immunotherapy, especially investigating the role of T-cell repertoire and T-cell lymphopenia in cancer progression. Dr. Lee has been worked as a consultant and SAB member for several biotech companies, collaborating for the development of novel cancer immunotherapeutics.
