Biography

You Jeong Lee has worked on the development and function of innate T cells such as NKT, MAIT and gamma delta T cells in mice and humans. Especially, he focused how the repertoire of these cells are selected and their lineage differentiation is regulated in the thymus. Recently he published paper which analyzed the developmental landscape of all three types of innate T cells at the single cell level at Nature Communications. In the future, he is interested in further analyzing factors determining TCR repertoire of innate T cells and role of these cells in IgE mediated immune disorders.
